

Pawnee Well Destruction Project

What	Destroy Pawnee Well, per San Bernardino County Department of Public Health Permit 2022070407. This will involve casing removal and filling bore hole with cement.
When	Construction will commence in beginning of August, 2022 and with completion expected by Mid-September, 2022. The Lucerne Valley Project working hours are from 7:00 am to 5:00 pm.
Where	The demolition of Pawnee Well will take place at 31371 Pawnee Street, Lucerne Valley, CA 92356.
What to Expect	Construction crews with backhoes, dump trucks, crew trucks and hand tools will be digging along the well-site. The services will generally be installed using an air compressor and pneumatic boring tool. The streets will remain open to traffic as the demolition is taking place inside the parcel. The initial phase will require cleaning of debris from the well by airlifting or bailing by reverse circulating drilling rig. The casing removal will be accomplished after explosive propelled perforating and may become noisy. The cement grout will be filled in the well, after removal of the casing. The construction crews will make every effort to keep dust to a minimum. Please expect an increased level of noise during the construction period. Weekly activities such as trash pick-up will not be interrupted. The well demolition will be done under supervision of Golden State Water Company Inspector and San Bernardino County Public Health Inspector. This step is necessary to protect public health and to ensure compliance with the Waterworks Standards. Following the successful demolition of well, the construction crew will restore the landscaping.
